

Boston Consulting Group

The Boston Consulting Group (BCG), a US consultancy active in Britain with NHS contracts, is mired in controversy over Gaza.

The Financial Times discovered that BCG staff, later sacked by the Group, helped set up the "Gaza Humanitarian Foundation", the US-Israeli scheme which has replaced the UN and international aid agencies. Over 740 Gazans have been gunned down seeking food at GHF sites. The US gov't gave the GHF \$30m.

The BCG "Aurora" project ran for 7 months with over \$4m of contracted work. Top level internal discussion included the chief risk officer and the head of social impact practice.

The Aurora team modelled postwar reconstruction. One scenario had 500,000 Gazans leaving with \$9,000 "relocation packages", or around \$5bn in total.

Tony Blair Institute

Two staff members at the Tony Blair Institute also participated in message groups and calls as the project developed and a TBI document on postwar Gaza was shared within the BCG team. TBI said it

Air cargo workers at Charles de Gaulle airport (Paris) refused to load military air shipments bound to Israel on 8 July. Dock workers in the port of Piraeus have refused to load the Ever Golden, a vessel carrying military-grade steel to Israel. "We will not unload a single inch of this murderous cargo," the ENEDEP union stated.

NHS Contracts

In the UK, the NHS Confederation partnered with BCG on a 'whole-of-government' approach to economic inactivity driven by long-term sickness.

North-West London Integrated Care Board paid the Group at least £2.3m for Acute Services, Service Redesign, Service Transformation, Professional and Consultancy fees.

The illegal occupation of Palestinian Territories, including the siege of Gaza, began long before 7th October 2023.
