

Gaza concentration camp

As we write, no-one knows if a Gaza ceasefire will be signed. But we do know:

- Israel proposed a massive “**Humanitarian Zone**”, a.k.a. concentration camp, in southern Gaza, another step to ethnic cleansing and possibly expelling Palestinians.

- **Ceasefire talks stalled** as Israel insisted on retaining the area for the Zone and the notorious “Gaza Humanitarian Foundation”. Palestinians seeking food are gunned down near the GHF sites.

- **The Boston Consulting Group** – also active in Britain – worked on plans for the GHF and calculated the cost of expelling Palestinians.

- Israeli forces are **killing ever more Palestinians** every day.

- The US and Britain keep **sending arms to Israel** even as some MPs, Peers and union leaders realise this is genocide.

Concentration camp

On 7 July, Israeli Defence Minister Israel Katz unveiled plans for a “Humanitarian Zone” between the Egyptian border and the “Morag Corridor” occupied by the IDF, crossing Gaza below Khan Younis.

Palestinians would be relocated into the Zone, vetted and not allowed to leave. Initially around 600,000 would come from Al-Mawasi, the so-called

Why Israel keeps journalists out of Gaza

French historian Jean-Pierre Filiu managed to enter last December. “The Gaza I knew no longer exists. Now I understand why Israel is denying the international press access to such an appalling scene.”

“In the past the schoolchildren of Gaza had uniforms and schoolbags,” Filiu writes. “Today they are street children, visited by death and wandering. They scrounge for paper, cardboard, nylon, anything that can be used to light a small fire and provide a bit of heat.”

“In the past, Gazan solidarity was high; the uncles and aunts, and the cousins, were very close to one another. Now everyone is focused on the small, dying, family circle. Wounded orphans remain abandoned in hospitals without relatives, even distant ones, coming to visit them.”

“safe zone” on the Mediterranean coast bombed over 20 times, featured in a film commissioned and then banned by the BBC.

Israel wanted to build the “Humanitarian Zone” during the temporary ceasefire, and force all civilian Gazans into the Zone. They would then be free to “voluntarily emigrate” from Gaza.

But the plan may be on the rocks. No-one wanted to accept Palestinians “voluntarily” kicked out of Gaza. The EU signed an agreement to deliver aid with the UN, which Israel had tried to exclude from Gaza but seems to have accepted. Trump’s envoy Witkoff told Israel the IDF must withdraw further. **What happens if Netanyahu’s far-right supporters react? Good question!**
