West Bank Annexation plan

Last summer, the International Court of Justice ruled that Israel's occupation since 1967, the creation of Israeli settlements and exploitation of natural resources, are illegal and must end. The UN General Assembly told Israel to comply by this September.

Twenty-two new illegal settlements were announced in late May, the biggest expansion in decades. Maps suggest the new settlements will be dotted across the entire West Bank, Defense Minister Israel Katz said the move "prevents the establishment of a Palestinian state that would endanger Israel".

Now the Israeli Knesset (Parliament) has voted 71-13 to annex the entire West Bank. The motion called on the Government to "apply Israeli sovereignty, law, judgment and administration to all the areas of Jewish settlement of all kinds in Judea. Samaria and the Jordan Valley," Israel's term for the West Bank.

Settlers obsessed with 2005

The plans include rebuilding former unofficial sites at Sa-Nur and Homesh, dismantled in 2005 when Israel also evacuated its Gaza settlements. Its Zionist leaders call that "expulsion" and still dream of return.

The illegal occupation of Palestinian Territories, including the siege of Gaza, began long before 7th October 2023.
