## Israel blocks ceasefire again

On 26 August, the Israeli Security Cabinet was expected to discuss the ceasefire offer tabled by the mediators Egypt and Qatar, and accepted by Hamas. The offer involved significant concessions.

Hamas dropped its demand that Israel withdraw entirely from the Philadelphi corridor running along the border with Egypt in southern Gaza. It agreed to remove language to prevent the U.S.-Israeli "aid" scheme run by the Gaza Humanitarian Foundation (GHF) from remaining in Gaza after a ceasefire. Over 2,000 Palestinians have been killed seeking aid since the GHF took over distribution in May.

Hamas consented to proposed Israeli "buffer zones" already encircling Gaza that would extend deeper into the enclave, in some cases agreeing to points that stretch 1,500 metres inside the territory.

## The Israeli Cabinet did not discuss the new offer.

Former US State Dept official Matt Miller told Israeli TV Channel 13 that previously "There were times we very much wanted to go public and make clear that we thought the prime minister was being completely intransigent and making it tougher to get a deal."

When Biden announced his 3-phase plan to end the war, "We told the government of Israel only an hour or two before the speech because, frankly, we [had]
