A Gaza'ceasefire' in name only

Palestinians hoped to recover from two years of genocide, but Israel continues to strike with impunity and nutritious food is nearly impossible to find.

The Reality

Almost every morning Israeli bombing can still be heard and the numbers of dead and injured civilians continue to rise. According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, since the 'end of the war' over 236 civilians have been killed and nearly 600 have been wounded. Figures from the Government Media office show Israel:

- Shot at civilians 88 times.
- Raided residential areas beyond the "yellow line" 12 times.
- · Bombed Gaza 124 times.
- Demolished people's properties on 52 occasions.
- Detained 23 Palestinians from Gaza.

The "Yellow line"

Gaza has been split in half with Israel controlling just over 50%. A 'yellow line' is marked out with concrete blocks and Palestinians are being killed for trying to cross or even get close to it. Behind the yellow line the military demolition, of Palestinian infrastructure continues.

Israel continues to **stop humanitarian aid** reaching Gaza's 2.3 million residents, creating what health officials describe as a **manufactured nutritional crisis**. Natalie Boucly, an UNRWA deputy commissioner general, says only half of the agreed 600 trucks a day are entering Gaza. According to AlJazeera, Israel keeps out protein-rich foods including meat, poultry, fish, and eggs while permitting entry of lower food value products like chocolate, chips, fizzy drinks and sunflower seeds.

End of ceasefire?

Israeli settlers who keep Netanyahu in power want a return to all-out war. The "ceasefire" is fragile, and no-one knows how long it will last. But it isn't peace.

- Demand the proscription of Palestine Action is reversed immediately

- Tell your MP to call out genocide, condemn the Gaza invasion, demand full access for the UN and aid agencies, comprehensive sanctions, a total arms embargo on Israel

The illegal occupation of Palestinian Territories, including the siege of Gaza, began long before 7th October 2023. Under international law, an occupied people have the right to resist the occupation, including by the use of force. Targeted attacks on civilians (by both Palestinian and Israeli forces on 7th October) are forbidden, but nothing that happened on 7th October justifies Israel's continued genocide of the Palestinians.
